This book comprises the essential primary and secondary insolvency legislation as well as detailed annotations and commentary written by leading experts of this area.

The update takes legislative amendments into account and incorporates the latest case-law regarding international insolvency and the EU Regulation on Insolvency Proceedings. Moreover, the Cross-Border Insolvency Regulations 2006 are analysed and their consequences for the common law system and its principles are demonstrated.

The authors' aim, to assist with practical problem-solving, is achieved by concentrating mainly on relevant decisions that develop or establish principles. Thus this book is especially useful to practitioners and judges who deal with those topics on a regular basis and need to be aware of the often far reaching implications of new decisions. The clear structure of this book, namely the fact that the statutory provisions are each followed by the corresponding commentary with headlines, enables the reader to quickly find an answer to a question.

With this edition a new, very attractive service will be introduced: as part of the Jordans Insolvency Online service this text will be published online and updated every six months. In this way the reader can ensure to get access to all current developments.

Providing all the relevant Insolvency Legislation as well as its analysis in a single volume, this comprehensive guide can be highly recommended to all practitioners.
